Purchases from service providers on route

Please take careful note of the purchases you make during your walk and check that you receive the correct orders when collecting your delivery at the end of the trip. Any purchases made by walkers on route are independent transactions between the walker and the service provider. Please ensure that you obtain full contact details of the service provider (eg. business card or brochure) for possible after service queries (delivery etc.) The Wellington Wine Walk team takes no responsibility for any problems that may arise in such circumstances.

First aid:

Our guides are competent to perform basic first aid and will carry the necessary kit.

In the case of a **medical emergency** that warrants immediate medical intervention, occurring, while on the walk, an ambulance and qualified medical persons will be brought to the guest for further attention.

This will be to the guest's personal account.

Please note: If you have any allergies (e.g. bees, pollen etc.), remember to bring your anti-allergy medication. You will be responsible for **informing the guide of any medical condition you may have** and for carrying your own prescribed medication.

Transporting Guests

We regret that the guides of Obiqualand Tours are not licensed to transport hikers who wish to opt out along the way. In such cases guests are to make use of their own vehicles to follow the hike and will be given a map of the route. Shuttles will be used for group transport but these are not easily available if not booked beforehand. The guides will only be able to handle medical emergencies which would require treatment and in cases like these we are not entitled to remuneration. I/We hereby agree to accept a lift (in case of illness or emergency on route), as a friend of the vehicle owner/driver without placing any liability on the owner/driver or the Wellington Wine Walk in the event of an accident.

Waiver Clause

I undertake to take part in the Wellington Wine Walk entirely at my own risk and I acknowledge the inherent risks in hiking. I agree that I shall have no claim whatsoever against Obiqualand Tours, Wine Scape Tours, Wellington Wine Walk, or the guides in their individual capacity in respect of any loss or damage to personal property, loss of money, personal accident, injury, or death, for the duration of the Wellington Wine Walk.
